

Buses on Detour this weekend for Picklesburgh and East Busway paving project

Buses to Detour for Picklesburgh, East Busway Paving

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (July 17, 2024) - About a dozen Pittsburgh Regional Transit bus routes are being detoured for Pittsburgh Downtown Partnership's annual Picklesburgh festival.

The 39-Brookline, 40-Mount Washington, 41-Bower Hill, 43-Bailey, 44-Knoxville, 48-Arlington, 51-Carrick, 51L-Carrick Limited, Y1-Large Flyer, Y45-Baldwin Manor Flyer, Y46-Elizabeth Flyer, Y47-Curry Flyer, and Y49-Prospect Flyer will remain on detour through midnight on Monday, July 22.

Riders can board these bus routes on Smithfield Street at Third Avenue, Smithfield Street at Forbes Avenue, or on Fifth Avenue at Wood Street (nearside). No outbound bus stops are affected by the detour.

Separately this weekend, the Martin Luther King Jr. East Busway will be closed from the Neville ramp to East Liberty Station from 9 p.m. Friday to 9 p.m. Sunday for paving work. Negley Station will be closed during this time. Buses will temporarily stop on Ellsworth Avenue at Negley Avenue.
